

BEGINNING PRODUCER AWARD

The Beginning Producer Award is given by the County of Grayson in cooperation with the Grayson County Agriculture Advisory Committee.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Beginning Producer Award is to encourage anyone who is in the beginning or developmental stages of their agricultural careers or endeavors. The goal is to provide recognition to those who are just getting into the field of agriculture and are looking to grow their knowledge both professionally and personally.

Eligibility:

All applicants must be citizens of Grayson County, VA or born in Grayson County. Individuals may be part time or full-time farmers/producers. Applicants must have 10 years or less of experience in the field of agriculture. Including, but not limited to, those who consider themselves “next generation” on a family farm, who have 10 years or less experience in a managerial role.

Awards:

The winner will be recognized and awarded \$1000.00 and a plaque.

The applicant or the sponsor of the applicant must submit the attached application outlining as completely as possible the work of the candidate and evidence of their effect on the agricultural life of the county. The statement should also cover the biography of the person including:

- Agricultural Activities (successes and accomplishments) (40 points)
- Obstacles overcome..... (15 points)
- Stewardship and Conservation Practices..... (15 points)
- Knowledge of Agriculture and Education..... (15 points)
- Community Leadership..... (10 points)
- Personality (include any additional information on biography) (5 points)

Applications reviewed by the Awards Committee and not awarded this year, may be resubmitted next year by simply updating the original nomination. Additional support material may be submitted.
